For Microsoft Windows and Apple macOS Computer

Follow this step-by-step procedure on your Microsoft Windows or macOS computer:

Step	Screen
<p>1. In your meeting/webinar controls, click Interpretation .</p> <p>2. Click the language that you would like to hear.</p> <p>3. (Optional) To hear the interpreter only, click Mute Original Audio.</p> <p>Notes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">You must join the meeting audio through your computer audio/VoIP. For Android and Apple iOS Mobile Devices

Follow this step-by-step procedure on your Android or Apple iOS mobile devices:

<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. In your meeting controls, tap the ellipses2. Tap Language Interpretation.3. Tap the language you want to hear.
