**CONSENT TO OR DECLINATION OF THE EXERCISE

Notice of a Magistrate Judge’s availability. A United States Magistrate Judge of this Court is available to conduct all proceedings, including trial, related to the above captioned Miscellaneous Proceeding and to enter a final order. The final order may then be appealed directly to the United States Court of Appeals like any other final order of this Court. A Magistrate Judge may exercise this jurisdiction only if all parties voluntarily consent. You may either consent to have your matter referred to a Magistrate Judge for the conduct and resolution of all proceedings in the litigation, or you may withhold your consent without any adverse consequences.

This document must be filed with the Court by Debtor or Debtor’s counsel after the date of service on the last party regardless of whether or not all parties are consenting to the exercise of jurisdiction of the Magistrate Judge.
